### Year 4 Spellings

Our spelling focus for Grammar this week is... doubling the consonant for a short vowel sound. The spelling pattern is usually found after a short vowel sound. For example: **r**abbit.

The spelling sound 'a' is pronounced the short way, so we double the consonant to add a suffix. This rule also applies when adding a suffix.

For example: **run** becomes **running**
